I write to you with excitement for the upcoming school year! It has been a busy summer at Bolivar Road and we look forward to welcoming your children back to school on Tuesday, September 3rd.

As you are aware, the front entrance and main office have been under construction since June. This capital project work includes safety and security upgrades such as a modernized double entry secure system for building access, a renovated main office with a security post for Officer Duby and an upgraded skylight theme vestibule. The main entrance will be complete for student and visitor arrival on the first day of school, while finish work in the main office will continue after school hours for a brief period to complete finishing touches.

Join me in welcoming the following staff members to the Bolivar Road family this school year: Juliana Beaumont (Library Media Specialist), Gabriella Borba (Instructional Aide), Alex Drake (Occupational Therapist - long term substitute), Emily Holst (4th grade), Melissa Stephens (School Nurse), Amber Thien (Instructional Aide) and Ashley Vescio (3rd grade).

The first day of school is Tuesday, September 3, 2024. Student drop off will take place from 8:20am-8:45am in the side parking lot. Students arriving after 8:45am are considered tardy and will need to be escorted to the main entrance and signed in by an adult. At the end of the day, student pickup will begin at 2:55pm and students taking bus transportation will be dismissed at 3:00pm. LATE ARRIVAL (AFTER 8:45 AM) (STUDENT DROP-OFF):

The exterior doors will be open for families to enter the main entrance vestibule. Once inside the first vestibule, please use the intercom to be allowed entry into a second vestibule. In this area, you will be greeted by an office member who will assist you.

EARLY DISMISSAL (BEFORE 2:55 PM) (STUDENT PICK-UP):

Parents/Guardians should park in the orange area indicated on the map and walk to the main entrance vestibule.

The exterior doors will be open for families to enter the main entrance vestibule. Once inside the first vestibule, please use the intercom to be allowed entry into a second vestibule. In this area, you will be greeted by an office member who will assist you.
